





## **Education OFFICER** **Lt/C Jeff Williams, JN**



January marks the start of our Spring slate of boating courses and seminars. Your education team is very excited to announce that you will have a chance to register for the following courses. Here's what's being offered in January and February.

### **Marine Navigation**

Gene Burson will be your instructor. This course begins on January 8th and focuses on navigation as is done on recreational boats today. It embraces GPS as a primary navigation tool while covering enough of traditional techniques so that you'll be able to find your way even if your GPS fails. The course includes many in-class exercises, developing your skills through hands-on practice and learning.

You will learn about:

- Charts and their interpretation
- Navigation aids and how they point to safe water
- Plotting courses and determining direction and distance
- The mariner's compass and converting between True and Magnetic
- Use of GPS – typical GPS displays and information they provide, setting up waypoints and routes, staying on a GPS route.
- Pre-planning safe courses and entering them into the GPS

- Monitoring progress and determining position by both GPS and traditional techniques such as bearings and dead reckoning

### **Anchoring with Assurance**

January 13th marks the start of our Tuesday night "Seminar Series". Jeff Williams will be your instructor for this 2-hour seminar. We will be offering more seminars that you're interested in throughout the Spring. Let us know what you'd like, and we'll schedule those seminars for you on Tuesday nights throughout the spring.

This Seminar will teach you how to anchor in a variety of situations, weather, or seabed and how to be prepared to adjust for changing conditions. Learn the skills and knowledge of securing your vessel to the bottom using a line, chain, and one or more anchors. Whether it's for fishing, swimming, a lunch break, or an overnight stop, one of the real pleasures in boating is "hanging on the hook" in some quiet spot. Emergencies such as loss of power, equipment breakdown or failure, or weather hazard may also require that your boat be anchored for a time. Good seamanship demands that all boaters know how to anchor safely. Anchoring topics begin with how to select an anchorage and how to anchor depending on conditions. After learning how anchors should be used, you will know if yours is satisfactory or what kind(s) to buy. The seminar covers useful anchoring tips and tricks and concludes by discussing how to moor and raft safely.

### **America's Boating Course**

Ted Reiss will be your instructor. This course begins on January 19th. America's Boating Course provides you with basic boating knowledge to decide what type and size boat you need, what to do when meeting another boat in a crowded waterway, and how to recognize and handle hazards. Become a more competent boater, learn from the best, and enroll in America's Boating Course today. Successful completion qualifies the student for the Florida Boating Safety Education Identification Card.

You will learn about:

- Types of boats and their uses
- Boating laws, both federal and state
- Safety equipment,
- Finding your way using Aids to Navigation (ATON's),

- Docking, undocking and securing your boat,
- Communications while on the water, and
- Trailering your boat

### Boat Handling Course

Nick Rago will be your instructor. The course begins February 5th. In the Boat Handling Course, you will learn how to handle your boat and gain greater confidence in docking, handling your boat underway, anchoring, and other seamanship skills. No matter how much boating experience you have, you will improve your boating skills by taking this course.

Boat Handling covers these topics:

- Rules of the Road: A practical Approach
- Confidence in Docking and Undocking: Slow Speed Maneuvering
- Boating with Confidence: Handling your Boat Under Way
- Anchoring with Assurance: Don't get Carried Away
- Emergencies on Board: Preparation for Handling Common Problems
- Knots and Line Handling: The Knots You Need to Know

### Tides and Currents

February 10th is the date for our 2nd “Tuesday Night Seminar”. Jeff Williams will be your instructor for this 2-hour. seminar. Learn how to cruise confidently in our coastal waters, secure in your knowledge of tidal conditions. Discover what causes the tides to rise and fall and what causes the currents to flow. Learn where to find sources of information about tides and tidal currents, simple ways to predict height of tide and speed of current flow and how to use both print and electronic tide tables.

With this seminar you'll learn:

- Causes and effects of tides and currents
- Predict the time of highest tide before it begins to fall
- Predict the vertical movement of the water
- Safely navigate low tide
- Determine the speed of the current and when it reaches maximum flood
- Deal with mean high and low water
- Use NOAA charts and tables

- Factor in tides and currents when anchoring
